[1] Prayer in the petition is against the order of the learned Addl. District Judge, Hoshiarpur in Rent Appeal No.RBT/11/30.05.2015, decided on 10.07.2018, assessing the mesne profit / compensation for use and occupation of the shop which is the subject matter of the instant proceedings @ Rs.6000/- per month recoverable by the landlord for the period during which the appeal remained pending.

[2] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner contends that vide order dated 12.10.2015 passed by the learned Rent Controller, Hoshiarpur, rent petition filed by respondent No.1 was allowed and ejectment of the petitioner ordered. Civil Revision No.5791 of 2018, challenging the order of the learned Appellate Authority, upholding the order of ejectment was dismissed as withdrawn vide order dated 12.03.2021 and pursuant thereto, the petitioner has handed over possession of the demised premises to respondent No.1, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioner does not wish to pursue the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the parties, the instant petition is *dismissed as withdrawn*.
