Pursuant to the order dated 09.02.2023, a demand draft for a sum of Rs.50,000/- in favour of the Poor Patients Welfare Fund, PGIMER, Chandigarh has been furnished.

The same is taken on record.

Registry is directed to ensure that the draft is deposited with the concerned authorities under the PGIMER, Chandigarh itself within a period of five days from today.

Counsel for the petitioner concedes that there has been a concealment of the material facts at the hands of the petitioner and factually incorrect instructions had been given to him and as such seeks withdrawal of the instant petition.

Such conduct at the hands of a litigant needs to be deprecated in strong terms. Since the cost of Rs.50,000/- has already been imposed and a draft in lieu thereof in favour of the Poor Patients Welfare Fund, PGIMER,

Chandigarh, has been furnished, we are inclined to accept the prayer of the counsel representing the petitioner as regards withdrawal of the petition.
