**MEENAKSHI I. MEHTA, J.(Oral)**

The petitioner herein has sought the relief of anticipatory bail in the criminal case arisen out of the FIR bearing No.5 dated 07.01.2023 as registered at Police Station Fatehgarh Churian, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur, under Sections 498-A and 406 read with Section 34 IPC.

2. Today, learned State counsel, on the instructions from ASI Jagtar Singh from the above-referred Police Station, informs the Court that in compliance of the order passed by the Co-ordinate Bench on 01.02.2023, the petitioner has joined in the investigation and his custodial interrogation

is not required and he is also not involved in any other criminal case.

3. In view of the afore-discussed submission as made by learned State counsel, the present petition is allowed and the relief of interim bail, as extended to petitioner-Ravinder Singh by the Co-ordinate Bench vide the said order dated 01.02.2023, is hereby made absolute.

4. However, the petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when required/called upon to do so and shall also strictly abide by all the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
