This common order shall dispose of aforementioned six contempt petitions as they are similar in nature.

Learned counsel for the respondent has filed the affidavit of Executive Engineer, Operation Division, Uttar Haryana Bijli Vitran Nigam Ltd. Naraingarh, Amala, separately in each petition, wherein it is stated that in compliance with the order passed by the writ Court, the necessary benefits have already been given to the petitioners. It is further stated that daily wages and work charge service rendered by the petitioners have been counted towards pensionary benefits and revised gratuity has been paid to them.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners

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submits that these petitions may be rendered infructuous with liberty to petitioners to challenge the claim of interest, raised by the respondent over the amount, which the petitioners have to deposit.

Ordered accordingly.

Rule stands discharged.
