LISA GILL, J.

This appeal has been filed by the appellant – husband challenging judgment dated 19.12.2018 passed by the learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), Kaithal, whereby his petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 has been dismissed.

It is informed that respondent has filed petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, seeking dissolution of their marriage.

Mediation between the parties is reported to have failed.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances as above, we find no ground whatsoever for continuation of these proceedings in the given factual matrix. However, appellant is at liberty to take up all available pleas before the learned Family Court, Kaithal in the pending petition under Section 13 of the Act filed by the respondent – wife.

Present appeal is, accordingly, disposed of.
