1. The petitioner herein is a tenant.
2. An application filed by the landlord under Order XLI Rule 27 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908, has been allowed by the trial Court to prove a rectification deed with respect to the tenanted property.
3. The tenant disputes the landlord-tenant relationship between him and respondent, though, he admits that the respondent's mother was her landlord.
4. Hence, no ground to interfere is made out.
5. Dismissed.
