The present petition is for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 to 5 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and further to take cognizance of the representation/complaint dated 20.01.2023 (Annexure P-1).

It is very strange that the petitioner, who was a married lady, alleges to have developed physical relationship with respondent No.6 and admits that she had conceived twice. However, since at that time, she had not been granted divorce from the first marriage, therefore, she willfully got the abortion done. Subsequently, she again conceived and this time, she has given birth to a baby girl and now by virtue of the present complaint, she is seeking direction for registration of FIR against the accused and his family members. The conduct of the petitioner does not inspire confidence and it is very strange that the petitioner as and when found convenient was ready to develop the physical relationship and now wants to lodge criminal

proceedings against respondent No.6. Even otherwise, the petition is pre-matured as the alleged representation is dated 20.01.2023 and the petition has been immediately filed on 30.01.2023. The conduct of the petitioner is not being highlighted in much word lest to demean a lady.

In light of the above, present petition is devoid of any merit and smell *mala fide* just to entangle respondent No.6 and his family members into unwanted litigation just because of her own convenience.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed. However, nothing mentioned in the present order shall construe any expression of opinion on the merits of the representation submitted by the petitioner. The same be dealt in accordance with law.
