1. This is an application for placing on record the statement of the complainant as Annexure P-4.

Main case

5. Petitioner is seeking to quash FIR No. 56 dated 23.02.2008 under Section 382 IPC, registered at Police Station City Phagwara, District Kapurthala and the order dated 21.03.2012, Annexure P-2 passed by learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Phagwara vide which the petitioner has been declared as proclaimed offender
6. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner shall surrender before the learned trial Court within a period of two weeks and has restricted his prayer only to the extent that appropriate directions

may be given to the concerned Court for expeditious disposal of the bail application.

7. Dismissed as withdrawn. However, it is directed that in the event the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within a period of two weeks, the learned trial Court shall look into the feasibility of expeditious disposal of the bail application that may be moved by the petitioner in accordance with law.
