The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.215 dated 06.04.2018 registered under Sections 120-B, 406, 420 IPC and Section 3 of the Haryana Protection of Interest of Depositors in Financial Establishment Act, 2013 (Sections 467, 468, 471, 204 IPC added lateron) at Police Station Sector-31, Faridabad.

By virtue of the order dated 08.08.2022, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel on instructions has submitted that the petitioner is already behind bars and in this case he has duly joined the investigation and he has no objection, if the interim order is made absolute.

In view of the above, the order dated 08.08.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
