SANDEEP MOUDGIL, J (ORAL)

1. The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari* for quashing the office order dated 25.01.2021 (Annexure P-5) with a further prayer to issue a writ in the nature of *mandamus* for directing the respondents to allow the petitioners to continue at their posts and for release of payment of back wages.
2. Mr. Arvind Seth, Advocate for respondents makes a statement before this Court that wages claimed in the present petition have been released to the petitioners for the period 01.04.2020 to 20.04.2022.
3. On the other hand, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are continuing in the job and in case, the wages, as stated by the counsel for respondents have been paid, nothing survives in the instant petition.

4. Mr. Arvind Seth is further directed to ensure that in case, the payments have not been released to the petitioners by the outsourcing agency to which the said amount has been released by the respondents, it shall be paid forthwith alongwith a receipt to be submitted to the Estate Officer, HSVP, Hisar.
5. In light of above, petition stands disposed of, having been rendered infructuous.
