This writ petition has been filed under Article 226 Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing the impugned order dated 24.12.2019 (Annexure P-3), whereby application filed by respondent No.3 under Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007 was allowed and petitioners were ordered to vacate the house in question.

Learned counsel for respondent No.3 states that the order dated 03.02.2020 directing the petitioners to deposit a sum of Rs.10,000/- towards litigation expenses has not been complied with.

A perusal of the case file shows that on 15.09.2022 more time was granted to the petitioners to comply with the order dated 03.02.2020 and thereafter, on 13.02.2023 last opportunity was granted to them. No one had put in appearance on behalf of the petitioners on the last date of hearing and it shows complete lack of interest in this petition.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.
