The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.PC for directing respondent Nos.2 and 3 to conduct a fair and impartial enquiry in FIR No.51 dated 25.11.2022 under Section 15 of the NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Fatehgarh Panjtoor, District Moga (Annexure P-3) on application dated 17.01.2023 (Annexure P-5) filed by the petitioner from some independent higher cadre Officer or from Crime Branch.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Adhiraj Singh, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State of Punjab.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that let this petition be disposed of only with a direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga to consider and decide the representation dated 17.01.2023 (Annexure P-5) alleged to have been submitted by the petitioner for conducting the fair and impartial inquiry in the said FIR.

Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the claim of the petitioner and even the assertions set out in the petition, the present

petition is disposed of only with a direction to respondent No.3 that if any such representation, as indicated above, is indeed pending consideration, it shall be dealt with expeditiously in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably within 4 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and convey the same to the petitioner.

The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
