This is a revision petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India praying for setting aside the ex-parte order dated 01.12.2022 (Annexure P-11) passed by Additional Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Moga in Execution Petition No.51 of 2022, with certain other prayers made in the present petition.

It is obvious that the possession of the premises has already been taken under the due process of Court. Not only that, the list of articles found inside the premises at the time of eviction, was also prepared by the Bailiff of the Court and the petitioner has been granted liberty to receive the said articles by following due course of law.
