The petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.342 dated 30.10.2022, registered at Police Station Sadar, Palwal, under Section 379 IPC (Sections 193, 407, 411, 420, 120-B & 201 IPC added later on).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated. There is no other criminal case pending against him and the trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date as charges have not yet been framed. Thus, the petitioner may be granted regular bail.

Custody certificate dated 12.02.2023 digitally signed by Sh. Sumit Panwar, Deputy Superintendent, District Prison, Faridabad has been filed in Court. The same is taken on record. A perusal thereof shows that the petitioner has undergone actual custody of 03 months and there is no other criminal case pending against him.

Learned State counsel concedes that charges have not yet been framed.

It is thus, evident that the trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date and keeping in view the period of custody undergone by the petitioner as well as the fact that there is no other pending criminal case against him, I deem it appropriate to grant regular bail to the petitioner. The petition is allowed and it is directed that the petitioner be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
