Both these writ petitions have been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India by the same petitioners seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing of two separate orders i.e. order dated 09.10.2018 (Annexure P-1) in CWP-2775-2019 and order dated 03.12.2018 (Annexure P-1) in CWP-3706-2019 passed by the NRI Commission- the respondent No.1.
