The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C for quashing the FIR No.85 dated 16.06.2021 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 323, 341, 506 read with Section 34 IPC (subsequently Section 201 IPC added), at Police Station Amargarh, District Malerkotla along with subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 27.01.2023 (Anneuxre P-2).

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that present petition has been rendered infructuous as the petitioners already stands acquitted and he has handed over a copy of the order dated 06.03.2023 passed by the Court of Judicial Magistrate First Class, Malerkotla, which is taken on record subject to all just exceptions.
