Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking directions to respondents No. 1 to 3 to conduct fair and impartial inquiry in FIR No. 225 dated 02.10.2022 registered under Sections 307 and 34 of Indian Penal Code and Sections 25, 27 of Arms Act at Police Station Ajnala, Jalandhar (Rural).

On 28.02.2023, learned State counsel has filed short reply and a perusal of para Nos. 6 and 7 of the said reply reveals that allegations made by respondent No. 4 were thoroughly investigated but the alleged involvement of petitioner Nos. 1 to 4 in causing injuries to the respondent No. 4 with a firearm did not prove and it was found that injuries to respondent No. 4 were caused by one of the person out of three unidentified persons by firing shots from his firearm, who had snatched the mobile phone and motorcycle of the petitioner No. 1 and the investigating officer is making sincere efforts to identify the real accused persons involved in the occurrence and to arrest them as early as possible.

In view of the above, nothing remains to be adjudicated in the present petition and the same is hereby disposed of, as such.
