The petitioner is seeking setting aside of order dated 23.11.2022 (Annexure P-1) vide which bail bonds of the petitioner were cancelled in case FIR No.36 dated 06.03.2022 under Section 21 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 registered at Police Station City Moga, District Moga and all other proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel for the petitioner at the outset submits that the petitioner is willing and ready to appear, and surrender before the Trial Court. A prayer has, therefore, been made that in the aforementioned facts and circumstances, the petitioner be protected till his appearance before the Trial Court and with directions to the Trial Court that his bail application, which he would be filing on his surrender, be decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Ramdeep Partap Singh, Sr.

DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

In view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of with directions to the petitioner to appear and surrender before the Trial Court on or before 08.02.2023. Till then, no coercive steps be taken against the petitioner.

It is made clear that in case, the petitioner fails to surrender before the Trial Court on or before 08.02.2023, this order shall be of no avail to him. In case, on appearance and surrender, the petitioner moves an application for bail before the Trial Court, the same shall be decided expeditiously by the Trial Court in accordance with law.
