VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)

1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to change the revenue entries of land comprised in Khewat/Khata No.208, 243, Rectangle No.40 Killa No.16(3-12), 17(8-18) measuring 12 kanals 10 marlas with respect to 1/4th share i.e., 3 kanals 2 marlas.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the suit of the petitioners against Noor Mohammad has been decreed and the appeal has also been dismissed by the Appellate Court and even, RSA against the same has been dismissed. It is further submitted that mutation entries have not been effected till date.

3. Learned State Counsel has submitted that the petitioners have not moved any application before the Assistant Collector, IInd Grade which is the competent authority to look into the entire matter.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present Civil Writ Petition with liberty to the petitioners to move an application before the Assistant Collector, IInd Grade. It is further prayed that the said application be decided as expeditiously as possible

5. In view of the above, the present Civil Writ Petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioners to move an application before the Assistant Collector, IInd Grade bringing out all the facts as have been stated in the present writ petition.

6. In case, such an application is moved then the Assistant Collector, IInd Grade, would consider the said application and decide the same, in accordance with law, after hearing all the concerned parties as expeditiously as possible.

7. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
