1. The connected writ petition No.11436-2017, was dismissed by this Court vide order dated 08.03.2017, for want of prosecution and on account of non-joining of necessary parties. But in the present case, the petitioner has impleaded the respondents, who were selected as BDPOs.
2. No one appears on behalf of the petitioner.
3. The petitioner has challenged the selection on the ground that the entire selection process has been conducted based on *viva-voce* test and submits that the selection should be based on written test followed by interview and the marks should be jointly counted for the purpose of selection. The petitioner has participated in the selection process and after he was not selected he has turned around and challenged the procedure of selection. In the opinion of this Court, a person cannot be allowed to approbate and reprobate at the same time.

4. In view thereof, the writ petition filed by the petitioner after having remained unsuccessful in the selection process cannot be entertained. The writ petition is dismissed accordingly.
5. All pending misc. application(s) also stand disposed of.
