1. This is a civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari setting aside the orders dated 07.11.1990 passed by respondent no.1 and 10.12.1988 passed by respondent no.2.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in the present case since as per the impugned order, respondent no.3 had granted two permits with one recovery right for a period of three years and on account of efflux of time, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
