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RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

1. This petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for quashing of FIR No.144 dated 18.03.2013 registered under Sections 323 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'the IPC') (Section 325 IPC added lateron) at Police Station Sector-34, Chandigarh and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise arrived at between the parties.

2. There is no representation on behalf of either of the parties.

3. Vide order dated 03.02.2023, the parties were directed to appear before the learned trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate, for getting their statements recorded; as to the genuineness of the compromise. In compliance thereof, report of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Chandigarh dated 03.07.2023, has been received, wherein, it has been mentioned that the parties did not appear to record their statements.
4. In view of the above, this Court does not find it appropriate to continue with the present petition any further.
