Prayer in the present petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to issue the required correct 'No Objection Certificate' (NOC), enabling the petitioner to join as Trained Graduate Teacher (English) at NCT Delhi, after correcting the NOC dated 24.11.2021 (Annexure P-3).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is permanent resident of Delhi; that the petitioner had joined as Post Graduate Teacher (PGT) English on 05.03.2014 in the Department of Education, Government of Haryana. Thereafter, the Delhi Subordinate Services Selection Board, published vacancy for TGT (English) for NCT Delhi vide advertisement No. 51/21 on 27.05.2021 and the petitioner being eligible applied for the post through proper channel under intimation to respondent

No.5 on 03.09.2021. The petitioner after her selection on the post of TGT (English), submitted an application for issuing 'NOC' and respondent No.2 issued the 'NOC' for the post of Principal, Govt. of NCT Delhi, instead of TGT (English). As the wrong 'NOC' has been issued by respondent No.2, the petitioner has submitted application for issuance of new/correct 'NOC', but neither the same has been granted or refused, hence, the present petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner will be satisfied, if respondent No.2 is directed to issue requisite new/corrected 'No Objection Certificate' within a stipulated period.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of this Court, learned State counsel accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Director, Secondary Education Haryana, to issue fresh 'No Objection Certificate' for the post of TGT (English) qua the petitioner and sent to the Delhi Subordinate Services Selection Board within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.

Learned counsel for the petitioner shall be duty bound to supply the copy of this order to respondent No.2 by tomorrow itself.
