This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for setting aside the impugned order dated 06.12.2021 (Annexure P-5), passed in the trial of case No. NDPS-179/2020 in FIR No.246 dated 16.09.2019 (Annexure P-2) under Sections 21, 22 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Amritsar, vide which arrest warrant of the petitioner has been issued and the bail bonds of the petitioner were cancelled and forfeited to the State illegally, without issuing any prior notice.
