The petitioners seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.533 dated 18.12.2022 registered under Sections 323, 452, 506, 120-B and 34 IPC at Police Station Sadar Dabwali, District Sirsa.

The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of the order dated 06.02.2023, petitioners have joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Madaan Lal admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioners are no more required for further investigation in the case, though a *Danda* is to be recovered.

Be that as it may, at this stage, no case for custodial interrogation is made out merely because a *danda* was to be recovered.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 06.02.2023 is made absolute. However, the petitioners shall keep on

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joining the investigation as and when required to do so and they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
