The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.95 dated 08.10.2022 under Sections 420, 447 IPC and Section 13 of the Punjab Travel Professional Act, 2014 registered at Police Station Sadar Nawanshahar, District SBS Nagar, Punjab.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 03.02.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Joginder submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 03.02.2023 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 03.02.2023 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
