1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 15.05.2017 passed in CWP-11740-2011.
2. Counsel for the State has filed affidavit dated 23.11.2017 submitted by the petitioner and has also placed on record compliance report dated 30.11.2023 filed by way of affidavit of Rakesh Chauhan, Engineer-in-Chief, Irrigation and Water Resources, Department, Haryana, mentioning the details regarding payment of the benefits, to show that the order dated 15.05.2017 has been complied with.
3. In view of the above, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
4. Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
5. However, if the petitioner is having still any grievance left unaddressed, he will be free to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
