This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 5 to hand over the investigation of case FIR No.44 dated 07.03.2022, registered under Section 346 IPC (Sections 344, 354(C), 384, 380, 506, 366A, 368, 457, 379, 376D, 376 (2) (n) of IPC, Sections 25, 54, 59 of Arms Act, 1959, Sections 66E and 67A of Information and Technology Act, have been added later on) at PS Bhattu Kalan, District Fatehabad, to some senior police officer not below the rank of IPS Officer or to some independent investigating agency, as official respondents in connivance with respondents No.7 to 9, are not conducting the investigation in a fair manner.

Learned State counsel submits that FIR in question is under investigation. There is no delay in investigating the case because the petitioner could be traced only on 31.07.2022. She has statedly married the accused/respondent No.6. It is further submitted that anticipatory bail petition filed by respondent No.6 is pending for 14.04.2023. Soon thereafter, investigation of the case would be complete.

In view thereof, there is no ground to issue the direction sought.

However, in case the petitioner or her family members apprehend any threat from anybody, she shall be at liberty to make an application to that effect to the police, which shall be considered by them and appropriate action will be taken.

Petition stands disposed of.
