1. Present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C for the grant of regular bail to the petitioner in respect of FIR No.118 dated 16.09.2021 registered under Section 22 (c) of the NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Nahianwala, District Bathinda, Punjab.

2. Learned State counsel, on the instructions from ASI Jagroop Singh, submits that only two prosecution witnesses have remained to be examined and the trial is near conclusion.

3. Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed qua the prayer for regular bail but the trial Court be directed to conclude the trial within a period of two months from the next date of hearing.

4. Learned State counsel raises no objection for the grant of said prayer.

5. Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case, though the prayer qua the grant of regular bail is disposed of having been not pressed but the trial Court is directed to conclude the trial under all circumstances within a period of three months from the next date of hearing.

5. The present petition is disposed of in above terms.
