The petitioner herein has sought the relief of regular bail in the criminal case arisen out of the FIR bearing No.395 dated 13.07.2022 registered at Police Station Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra, under Sections 323, 342 & 376-D IPC.

Learned State counsel submits that the criminal case under reference has reached its final stage and it is scheduled to be listed before the trial Court on 29.09.2023 for recording defence evidence, if any and also for hearing the final arguments.

In view of the above-discussed submission as made by learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition, while praying that the trial Court may be

directed to decide the afore-said case within some specific time frame.

Learned State counsel has no objection for the same.
