Petitioners have approached this Court praying for quashing of FIR No.61 dated 01.06.2022, under Sections 323, 325, 34 of IPC and Section 308 of IPC added subsequently vide G.D. No.31 dated 17.09.2022, registered at Police Station Kathu Nangal, District Amritsar along with subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 05.01.2023 (Annexure P-3).

It has been contended by counsel for the petitioners that originally the FIR was registered for the offence under Sections 323, 325, 34 of IPC, however, subsequently, offence under Section 308 IPC was added in a deliberated manner. He submits that the dispute is among the relatives and both the sides have amicably resolved the dispute.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Sandeep Kumar, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Mr. Gobind Singh Randhawa, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.2 and 3.

He affirms the submissions made by counsel for the petitioners.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurjinder Singh, submits that the matter is pending investigation as the report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has not been submitted as on date.

Heard. After hearing counsel for the parties and perusing the record, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the State to conclude the investigation keeping in view the submissions made by both the parties within a period of one month from today.
