Petitioners have approached this Court with a grievance that there has been no development in the residential township and the basic amenities are not being provided, which the respondents are mandated under the statute and the rules framed thereunder.

Counsel for the petitioners contends that highlighting the grievances, a legal notice dated 19.11.2022 (Annexure P-4) has been served upon the respondents but till date, the same has not been responded to. His submissions is that the petitioners, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the respondents to consider the legal notice referred to above and take a decision thereon within some specified time.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Pravindra S. Chauhan, Sr. Addl.

A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

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In the light of the statement made by the learned counsel for the petitioners, the present writ petition is disposed of without going into merits of the case or commenting thereon, directing respondents No.1 to 3 to consider the legal notice dated 19.11.2022 (Annexure P-4) and take a decision thereon within a period of six weeks from today. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioners forthwith.

If some force is found in the grievance(s) as highlighted in the legal notice dated 19.11.2022 (Annexure P-4), the consequential steps be taken in pursuance of such decision within a further period of six weeks.
