HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J.(Oral)

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has secured 63 marks in the written examination and the last selected candidate under the BCB category has secured 64 marks and there were candidates from the waiting list who were selected despite having lesser marks than the petitioner and even the said waiting list has been exhausted so as to fill the posts which were advertised. Hence, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner to approach the respondents/competent authority raising his grievance that candidates having lesser merit than the petitioner have already been selected and especially when the posts are still lying vacant.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case any representation is filed by the petitioner, the same will be considered in accordance with law and an appropriate order will be passed within a period of eight weeks after receipt of the representation.

3. Keeping in view the statement made by the learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty as prayed for.
4. Ordered accordingly.
5. Any civil miscellaneous application pending, if any, is also disposed of as such.
