This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to the respondents to conduct fair and impartial investigation in case FIR No.1178 dated 10.12.2022, registered under Sections 323, 328, 376-D, 506 IPC and Section 3 (1)(r) (3) (2) (v) of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, at P.S.Barwala, District Hisar, and to hand over the investigation of the said case to some independent agency, as respondents No.5 and 6 are conniving with the accused persons.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Nehra Singh, submits that pursuant to lodging of the FIR, further investigation was conducted by the police and the allegations levelled therein were found to be false. Therefore, a cancellation report dated 25.01.2023 has been prepared and sent for approval of the higher officers.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the petition with liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law.

Permitted to do so.

Petition stands dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
