Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.60 dated 2.2.2022 registered under Sections 120-B, 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC at Police Station Gurgaon Sadar, District Gurugram.

The dispute between the parties is with regard to plot which was originally owned by Amir Singh father of the complainant-Ramesh who is alleging that his father gave one power of attorney in his name with regard to the said plot. Petitioner No.1 who has since died was real sister of Suman wife of complainant-Ramesh and petitioner No.2 is husband of petitioner No.1.

State counsel as well as counsel appearing for the petitioners apprised the Court that petitioner No.1-Dr. Suman has died on 26.7.2022

and copy of her death certificate is taken on record.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner No.2 has joined the investigation with the police in compliance of order of interim bail dated 15.2.2022 passed by Coordinate Bench of this Court.

State counsel on instructions from ASI Raju submits that petitioner No.2 who has joined the investigation with the police, is not required for any further investigation or custodial interrogation by the police and that the police is going to file challan against petitioner No.2 in the Court concerned very shortly.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 15.2.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
