The challenge in the instant revision petition is to the order dated 10.10.2019, passed by the Court of learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Jalandhar (Annexure P-1), whereby the petitioner/plaintiff has been directed to pay *ad valorem* Court fee on Rs.50,00,000/-, claimed as damages from the respondent.

In the present case, notice of motion was issued on 29.04.2021 for 12.07.2021.

As per office report, due to non-furnishing of requisite process fee along with copy of revision petition, notice could not be issued for 12.07.2021. It has further been stated in the office report that learned counsel for the petitioner has furnished the process fee on 07.09.2021, which was returned as notice of motion was issued for 12.07.2021.

On the last date of hearing i.e. 02.05.2023, no one appeared on behalf of the petitioner and Registry was directed to inform the learned counsel for the petitioner about the date fixed.

As per office report, learned counsel for the petitioner has been informed about the date of hearing through e-mail, however, even today, none has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner.

It appears that the petitioner is not interested to pursue the instant revision petition.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.
