On 28.02.2023, the following order was passed in this case:-

“The prayer in the present petition under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.63 dated 13.5.2013 under Sections 21/29/61/85 NDPS Act, registered at P.S. Chattiwind, District Amritsar.

The Counsel for the petitioner contends that on account of noting down of a wrong date the petitioner was unable to appear on 25.11.2022 on which date NBWs were issued pursuant to which proclamation proceedings were begun. He contends that petitioner is ready and willing to join proceedings once again.

Notice of motion for 19.04.2023.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to surrender before the Trial Court within a period of one week from today and subject to their depositing Rs.10,000/- as costs with Senior Citizen Home, Udyog Patrh, Sector 15-D, Chandigarh he shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of the Trial Court”.

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In compliance of the aforementioned order, the petitioner has surrendered and has since been released on interim bail vide order dated 06.03.2023 passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar. A copy thereof is taken on record as Mark ‘A’..

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court. Disposed of.

It is expected that the petitioner shall henceforth not absent himself from the Trial but for sufficient cause.
