The petitioner is seeking issuance of appropriate directions to the official respondents to look into his representation dated 13.12.2022 (Annexure P-7) and register a criminal case against the private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the private respondents in connivance with each other had fabricated a Will (Annexure P-5) on behalf of mother of the petitioner with an intention to grab the property of the petitioner.

Notice of motion to official respondents only.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Ramdeep Partap Singh, Sr. DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

Learned State counsel on instructions has apprised this Court that pursuant to receipt of representation (Annexure P-7), the authorities concerned had made necessary enquiries, however, no grain of truth was found in the allegations levelled and it came to the fore that the dispute, if any, was essentially of civil nature.

I have heard learned counsel and perused the relevant

material on record.

No ground is made out for issuance of directions as prayed for.

Dismissed.

However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail of alternate remedies as may be available to him under the provisions of law.
