1. This is an application under Section 151 of the CPC for recalling of the order dated 23.02.2023 vide which the main writ petition has been dismissed for want of prosecution.

2. Notice in the application to the respondents.

3. For the reasons mentioned in the application, which is duly supported by an affidavit, the same is allowed. The order dated 23.02.2023 is recalled and the main writ petition is restored to its original number.

CWP-3022-2019

1. This is a civil writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of an appropriate writ, order or

direction especially in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to take legal action against respondent no.7, in accordance with law.

2. Learned State counsel has submitted that the complaint of the petitioner has been looked into and nothing has been found against respondent No.7 and thereafter, the said complaint has been filed and thus, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to seek appropriate remedy, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the above statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with the aforesaid liberty.
