The prayer under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.80 dated 19.11.2022 under Sections 457, 380 411 IPC registered at Police Station Sehna, District Barnala.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 14.03.2023 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 14.03.2023 and is not required for custodial interrogation.
