Through the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. the petitioner seeks quashing of order dated 20.12.2022 passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Kurukshetra through which while entertaining the petitioner's appeal filed by him against his conviction by the trial court, he has been ordered to deposit 20% of the awarded compensation.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not press the present petition on its merits and would be satisfied if he is permitted to deposit the awarded compensation in installments.

After considering the arguments raised on behalf of the petitioner, the alternate prayer made on his behalf is found to be reasonable and accordingly it is directed that the amount to be deposited in terms of the impugned order shall now be deposited within 60 days from today.

Disposed of.

In case the respondent is aggrieved by passing of this order, he is at liberty to approach this Court by filing an appropriate application.
