The instant petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 294 dated 16.06.2018 , registered under Sections 420, 467, 468 and 471 of IPC, at Police Station Dharuhera, District Rewari.

As per order dated 11.09.2023, the petitioner had deposited a sum of Rs. 50,000/- with the complainant-bank. On the last date of hearing, the learned counsel for the petitioner had made a statement that he shall produce the draft of remaining amount of Rs. 1,10,000/- on the next date of hearing.

During the course of hearing, the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant-bank submits that the amount of Rs. 1,10,000/- has been deposited by the petitioner with the complainant bank.

In view of the statement made by the learned counsel for the complainant, the interim order dated 19.07.2023 is made absolute and the petition is allowed. The petitioner shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
