The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C praying for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.70 dated 1.2.2022 registered under sections 406, 420 IPC at Police Station, Ambala City, District Ambala.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in pursuance to the undertaking given on 13.12.2022 before this court, petitioners have deposited an amount of Rs.2.10 lakh with the Trial Court and have also joined investigation in pursuance to order dated 9.3.2023. He submits that the interim order dated 9.3.2023 may kindly be made absolute.

Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the submissions made by counsel for petitioners. He submits that complainant in this case is a commission agent and the petitioners have to pay a sum of Rs.9 lakh with interest to him.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurmej Singh has endorsed the fact that petitioners have joined investigation and

submitted that they are no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 9.2.2023 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C and the petition stands allowed. It is, however, made clear that the amount of Rs.2.10 lakh deposited by the petitioners with the Trial Court would be kept in the shape of FDR of a Nationalized Bank and the same would be released subject to final decision of the case to the party as per its entitlement.
