1. On 14.02.2024, the following order was passed by this

Court:-

“In pursuance to the last order i.e. 07.02.2024, reply by way of affidavit dated 14.02.2024 of Sh. Manavjit Singh Sidhu, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Tapa, District Barnala has been filed on behalf of respondent-State. The same is taken on record. Copy of the same has been supplied to the opposite counsel.

A perusal of the reply reveals that, there are total 10 accused persons, as on today, who are involved in commission of the present crime, and the victimcomplainant has suffered about 07 injuries. A perusal of the reply further reveals that no specific injury is attributed to the present petitioner, though he was involved along with the other co-accused in the commission of offence.

Considering the fact that the case is triable by the Court of Judicial Magistrate concerned, and the present petitioner is not involved in any other criminal case, and thus, has clean antecedents, this Court deems it appropriate to direct the petitioner to join the investigation, and to appear before the investigating agency within 15 days from today. In the event of his arrest, he shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing bail bond to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Adjourned to 14.03.2024.”

2. Learned State counsel, on instructions imparted to him by ASI Santosh Singh, submits that the petitioner has already joined the investigation in pursuance to the aforesaid order, and he has fully co-operated with the investigation process, and he is no more required for any further custodial investigation.

3. In view of the specific stand taken by the learned State counsel, the present petition is allowed, and order dated 14.02.2024 is, hereby, made absolute, on the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
