This is an application filed for grant of leave under Rule 3/A(1) of Chapter VI, Part B, Volume V of Punjab and Haryana High Court Rules and Orders to file the present petition.

Main case

This is the second petition filed under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.141 dated 20.06.2020 registered under Sections 302, 120-B, 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and
