This petition has been filed seeking a direction to the official respondents No.2 to 5 for taking action in case FIR No. 175 dated 19.08.2022 under Sections 147, 149, 323, 342, 354-A, 379, 506 and 508 of IPC, 1860 and Section 3(1), (ZA) (C) of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, registered with Police Station Behal, District Bhiwani (Annexure P-1), since respondents No. 6 to 13 were stated to be roaming around and extending threats of elimination to the petitioners.

2. Learned State counsel has filed status report in the Court today and the same is taken on record. She contends that investigation in the case has been carried out and final report under Section 173 (2) has been presented in Court. She further contends that eleven accused persons have been arrested and 15 named persons have not been found involved in the commission of offence on the basis of investigation and remaining six

accused are yet to be arrested and warrants of arrest have already been issued against them by the Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, for 02.07.2023.

- 3. In view thereof, no direction is required to be issued.
- 4. Accordingly, the petition stands disposed of.
- 5. Since the main case has been decided, pending application(s), if any, stands disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
