1. In this revision petition, the correctness of the order passed by the Civil Court on 18.01.2022, while dismissing the petitioners application for rejection of the plaint has been challenged.
2. The learned counsel representing the petitioners contends that the respondent has filed the suit for grant of decree of permanent injunction on the basis of an agreement to sell dated 25.03.2021, which has not been signed by any of the party. He refers to page 52 and 53 of the paperbook.
3. On a Court question, the learned counsel representing the petitioners admit that this fact was not taken up in the application filed under Order VII Rule 11 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908.
4. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the revision petition is disposed of.
5. The petitioner, if so advised, may file another application under Order VII Rule 11 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908, in accordance with law.

6. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
