Prayer in the present petition is for the issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to decide and properly investigate into the representations dated 02.11.2018, 18.11.2018 and 14.01.2019 (Annexures P-6 to P-8) submitted to respondent No.3 and to direct respondents to take prompt action keeping in view the fact that the life and liberty of the petitioners is in danger.

No one has appeared on behalf of the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the respondent informs the Court that the petitioners are the mother-in-law and father-in-law respectively of respondent No.4 and there were regular disputes amongst them. On the basis of the complaints referred to in the present petition, DDRs were

registered. Reference has been made to the status report submitted by the respondents No.1 to 3 in this regard. It has been submitted that prompt action had always been taken on the complaints submitted by the petitioners and even in the last Complaint dated 09.03.2020 submitted by the petitioners, a DDR was registered promptly and they were enquired together. It has been submitted after that no complaint has been filed by the either side.

Since no one has appeared on behalf of the petitioners, it appears that they are no longer interested in pursuing the matter and may very well have settled their disputes one way or the other.

Resultantly, this petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
