1. This writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari or any other appropriate writ, order or direction, quashing notices (Annexures P-5 to P-9).

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.3 has submitted that before any order in the said notices is passed, the petitioner has filed the present writ petition and has thus submitted that the present writ petition is premature. It is further submitted that an order on the said notices, after taking into consideration the reply filed by the present petitioner and also after giving personal hearing to the petitioner would be passed by the Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Faridabad

(respondent No.3), in accordance with law, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the said statement satisfies the claim of the present petitioner. It is further prayed that respondent No.3 be bound by the said statement.

4. In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.

5. Respondent No.3 would be bound by the statement made before this Court.

6. Needless to say that in case the decision by respondent No.3 is against the present petitioner, it would be open to the petitioner to challenge the same in accordance with law.

7. Pending application, if any, stands disposed of in view of the above.
