This is a revision petition against the order dated 05.12.2022 passed by the Family Court, Narnaul, granting interim maintenance under Section 125 Cr.P.C. to the petitioner/wife.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the interim maintenance of ₹7500 per month to the petitioner/wife is on the lower side as the respondent/husband did not disclose his true income.

A perusal of the impugned order shows that the respondent/husband is posted as FSM in Chola Mandalam Insurance Company at Gurugram. He was found to be earning ₹39,000 per month, and the petitioner/wife ₹25,000 per month by sewing and beauty parlour work.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has not been able to dispute the respondent's monthly income on the basis of any documentary evidence/material. Nor is he in a position to deny the wife's income. Therefore, at this stage, it cannot be held that amount of interim maintenance awarded to the petitioner/wife is on lower side. Besides, trial of the case is going on, and the petitioner/wife is at liberty to prove that the respondent/husband is earning any higher amount than assessed by the Court.

Petition stands dismissed.
